## Roundtable Discussion

## Abstract requirements

- Materials must be submitted in **Microsoft Office Word (.doc or .docx) format**; margins on all sides: 20 mm; font: **Times New Roman**, size 14; line spacing: 1.5, the indent of the first line: 1.25 . The length of the abstract should be **1 to 5 pages**.
- **The language of the abstract must be English.**
- The **file name** should be written in **Ukrainian or English** according to the participant's first and last name (e.g., Ivanenko Andriy\_abstract).
- **References in the text** should be placed in square brackets indicating the reference number of the source (e.g., [1]). The numbering of references in the text must correspond to the numbering in the **reference list** at the end of the abstract, titled "**References**", with full bibliographic details formatted according to **APA style**.
- When writing abstracts, please adhere to the principles of **academic integrity**. All abstracts will be checked for **textual plagiarism**.
